USDA Requirements on all CAGED ANIMALS.

- All cages need to have a solid bottom, escape hatch & handles to lift cages.
- Containers with Food & Water attached.
- All cages must have enough space to move around according to the industry standards for such animal.
- All cages must have sufficient bedding according to the species
- "Live Animal" sticker needs to be attached to every cage, on side & top including birds.
- All cages requiring USDA License must have buffers on sides (pvc pipe works well.)
- Basically, all cages must meet or be above USDA requirements to enter sale.

Due to USDA regulations we no longer will accept **GUINEA PIGS & RABBITS.**

Please **NO EXCEPTIONS** on cage requirements. If they do not meet inspection of veterinary, cage & animal cannot be accepted.



SCAN ME

Check with your vet for health papers and Coggins tests.

Notice: Health papers can be issued at the auction for Ohio consignments. All out of state consignments must have health papers and entry permit upon arrival. ALL equine must have Coggins upon arrival from all states including Ohio.

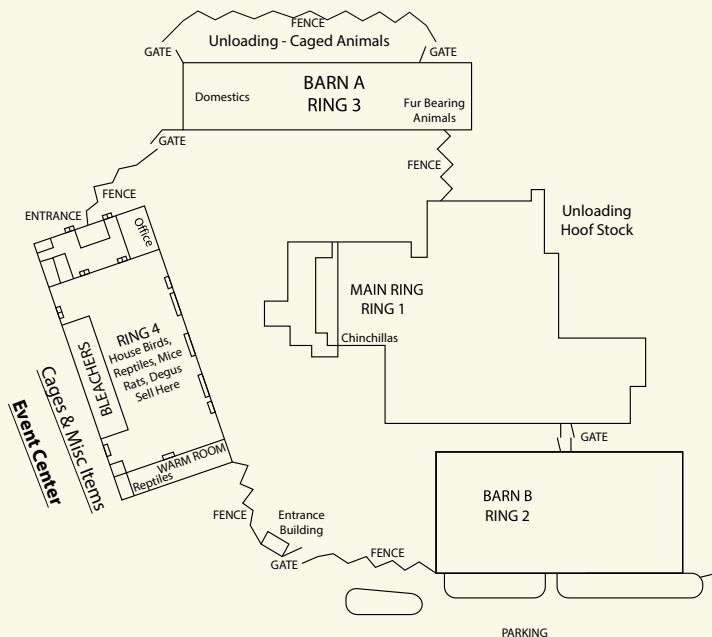

! IMPORTANT !

USDA animals require USDA license.
We request show of USDA license when unloading. No animal requiring USDA can be sold without USDA license.

! NOTICE !

All animals and birds must meet the following requirements or they cannot be sold.
NO EXCEPTIONS!

OHIO CONSIGNORS need not have an entry permit number but must still have an official health certificate for all animals and birds or they will not be sold. Our sale vet can issue health papers for Ohio consignors only but stock will not be sold until a copy has been received by the check-in crew. Therefore, to avoid delays after your arrival it would be to your benefit to have your local vet issue your health certificate!

OUT OF STATE

HEALTH CERTIFICATE ENTRY PERMIT

All eligible animals must be accompanied by an official health certificate from the state of origin issued within 30 days of entry. This information can be obtained from your local veterinarian or the Div of Animal Health (614-728-6220). Animals or birds entering the state may also require an Ohio entry permit number. IF a permit is required, please write it on the health certificate. To obtain an entry permit, you must fax your health paper to Ohio Div. of Animal Health at least 24 hours in advance. Fax 614-752-3065

Ohio Wildlife Laws call 614-644-3925 for permits needed for your animal and game birds.

Out of state consignors need Ohio Propagation Permit. Get in the District 1 office. 614-644-3925.

Health certificates on all animals and birds must show each individually identified and listed separately by sex and age. In the event sex can not be determined, "unsexed" should be indicated for that animal. If age is not known or can not be determined, such animals should be indicated as either adult or juvenile.

! NOTICE !

The following animals and birds must have official negative test papers if they originate from out-of-state.

NO WHITETAIL DEER

★ELK, RED DEER, MOOSE, REINDEER, FALLOW, SILKA, AXIS, MUNTJAC & PURE DAVID

All cervidae require the following to import into Ohio:

- ★Cervidae need 5 year CWD to be imported into Ohio.
- ★If the herd is NOT TB Accredited through the originating state, then they must have a whole herd test within 12 months of entry and an individual test within 90 days of entry. The whole herd and individual test must be at least 90 days apart.
- ★If the herd is not brucellosis certified through the originating state, then all animals 6 months and older must have a negative brucellosis test within 30 days of entry.
- ★Official individual identification, CVI within 30 days of entry & a permit number. Documentation must be faxed to the division of Animal Health to obtain the permit number.
- ★Official ID required for Intrastate movement of WT deer (new).

NOTE:

We strongly recommend that Elk, Red Deer (even calves), and Fallow Deer of any age be 4-way tested. (TB, Bangs, Blue tongue, Antiplasmosis). It will increase their value and allow them to be imported into a greater number of states. However, all deer & elk from Ohio can be sold without a test if they stay in Ohio.

★All sporting type swine must also be tested for Brucellosis & Pseudorabies, Russian Wild Boars & Crossbreds even if they are from Ohio. Pot-bellied Pigs don't need to be tested.

★Negative Brucellosis test within 30 days of the last day of this auction, or originate directly from a validated Brucellosis free herd.

★Negative Pseudorabies test within 30 days of the last day of this auction, or originate directly from a Pseudorabies qualified herd.

★ALL EQUINES - must have a negative EIA within 12 months, oos (out of state) equine also require a CVI and oos Zebras require a permit number. Coming to Ohio: No Equine without Coggins and health paper.

★BISON, BUFFALO, YAK, ETC. - all require official individual identification-CVI

★LLAMAS & ALPACAS - require official individual ID and a CVI.

★SHEEP & GOATS - all require official scrapie identification.-CVI

★All turkeys must be lab tested negative for pullorum/fowl typhoid within 30 days of the last day of this auction, prior to their arrival, or originate directly from a NPIP flock within one year.

★The Rapid Whole Blood test shall not be used. All turkeys which have not been tested prior to their arrival will not be accepted!

★Ring-neck pheasants will need a propagation permit and proof of license number.

★ Out-of-State Ratites must have a CVI.

! NOTICE !

★PULLORUM FOWL TYPHOID TESTING ON CHICKENS, GAME BIRDS, PEAFOWL & DOMESTIC POULTRY

* We will offer testing at the barn for \$2.00 per bird. We encourage those who have access to an approved tester to have their birds done prior to arrival. This will reduce the confusion and inconvenience here at the auction.

All Domestic Poultry in Ohio need to be tested. Also, AI testing required for certain states. Please bring paper work along. It can help you sell your birds to more buyers.

All Swans will be Barn Sexed regardless, which will be paid by the consignor.

NOTE TO CONSIGNORS:

Health regulations throughout the country have undergone some major changes in the past year. Many states are now addressing "exotic animal regulations." We have set the preceding regulations for our auction to accommodate the greatest amount of other state's regulations, and to meet or exceed the requirements of this state. This is necessary due to the amount of stock that is bought by out-of-state buyers. If the consignor wants the best price for their product, then they must insure its marketability to a greater number of buyers. All health papers written by our vet are \$15.00 each.

NOTICE TO BUYERS:

- ★Vet fee on all animals and birds will be \$1.00 per head or per cage, to be paid by buyer.
- ★Buyers are responsible to pick up their health certificates from the vet before departure.
- ★Buyers, our vet will assist you in getting the proper permits, testing, and papers to take your animals home.
- ★Buyers, it is your responsibility to know your state's regulations and requirements, so be sure before you buy, that the animal is tested to meet your state's entry requirements.
- ★Buyers, certain animals require permits or licenses to own, some require permits or licenses to buy. Please be aware of this before bidding on the animal.
- ★Please be sure your papers are in order and you have thorough knowledge of the animal being purchased, including state requirements of keeping the animal.

ALL STOCK SUBJECT TO THE SCRUTINY OF OUR VET. WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ANIMALS IN POOR HEALTH, SUFFERING FROM SEVERE STRESS OR INJURY, OR WITH EVIDENT DISABLING DEFORMITIES, EXHIBITING SIGNS OF COMMUNICABLE OR INFECTIOUS DISEASE. WE ACCEPT "SOUND" ANIMALS ONLY.



CONTAINMENT & CARE REQUIREMENTS

★No snakes, etc. in bags.

★No cardboard or closed containers accepted!

★Cages will sell with animals and birds!

★All animals must be in cages except hoofed stock, Wallabies & Kangaroos.

★All birds must be in cages except Swans, Ratites, Cranes, Storks & Flamingoes.

★Feeding and watering of all animals is the responsibility of the owner! Buyers remember, after sale is called, YOU are the owner! Care for it!

★There will be \$2 per head per day feed charge for hoofed stock (Hay and water only).

★BOARDING OF ANIMALS (at consignor or buyer expense) prior to or after the sale is no problem, but you must clear these plans with the office.

★Primates—large species of primates are not permitted. For an entire list, please review SB 310, as legislation restricts what animals we can/cannot sell.

★No house cats, Bengal cats, wolves, hybrid wolves, crossbred cats, tigers, bears, or lions of any kind permitted.

Please have all your registration papers and transfers signed and in order. Otherwise we will hold your check.

★No venomous constrictors or large species of snakes permitted. Again Ohio Law SB 310 restricts ownership and breeding of all animals listed. Check out our website for animals included.

★No insects - including cockroaches, walking sticks, and any plant eating insects.

Deductions can be made - checks will be issued Wednesday following the sale.

TERMS:

Cash, cashiers check, pre-approved check with bank letter of credit, money orders, travelers checks (U.S. Funds). Major credit cards accepted. 3% Buyer Premium on all purchases refunded with cash or check payments.

SEATING:

General Admission: \$5.00. Anyone on grounds needs to pay admission.

Reserved Seats: Additional \$10.00. Seating capacity for main ring is limited, so call early if you want a reserved seat. The seats must be paid in advance if you are getting two or more.

COMMISSION:

Every item 20% on first \$100.00; 13% from \$101.00-\$500.00; 8% after \$500.00; \$3.00 minimum per lot. No Sales are 1/2 commission with \$35.00 maximum.

Also: Minimum commission for Potbelly Pigs, Goats and sheep is \$7.50 per animal. Rest of hoof stock minimum is \$10.00 per head.

All sales and guarantees are between buyer and seller. No alley trading or private sales on Auction premises.

No video cameras or cameras are allowed on premises. No photos or recording permitted.
